WENDY WALSH

Fused Glass Artist

As I found out from Wendy, fused glass is a huge subject! There are many different forms of glass that can be fused. Those include powdered glass; frit, which is crushed glass in three sizes ranging from fine sand to pea gravel; stringers, which are 1 or 2 millimeter wide fine strings of glass 18-inches long; and sheet glass. All of these can be used together in any combination and come in a wide variety of colors that include both transparent and opaque glass.

Once a project is constructed, it is heated in a digitally controlled kiln that Wendy programs to heat the glass slowly enough that it will not thermal shock and crack. The glass becomes uniformly hot before being brought to the process temperature ranging from $1325^\circ\mathrm{F}$ for a tack fuse to $1470^\circ\mathrm{F}$ for a full fuse. A tack fuse means the glass has reached a temperature hot enough to stick together, but individual pieces still retain their 3-dimensional shape. A full fuse occurs when the glass totally melts into each other, showing only differences in color to define the original shape. After the glass has been heated to the process temperature, it needs to be cooled slowly over hours again so that it does not thermal shock and break. This generally means a piece will be in the kiln for 12 to 15 hours. A finished piece of work usually requires a minimum of two firings in the kiln, and often more.

After a composition comes out of the kiln, it needs to be "cold worked," which includes smoothing, rounding and polishing edges, which she does on a flat lap grinder with increasingly finer grits of diamond and polishing pads. The glass may also be sandblasted and then refired in the kiln to give a matte finish. Some of Wendy's pieces involve cutting glass that has come out of the kiln and reconfiguring it before putting it back in to be refused.

The things Wendy likes best about fusing glass are the luminescent colors of glass, the wide variety of techniques that can be done, and the different things that can be produced. She has made bowls, trays, wall art, vases, and other decorative pieces. She estimates she has taken 75 classes around the country from an array of nationally and internationally known artists. The techniques and experience she gains in classes are cumulative and add to an overall body of knowledge that she feels lends itself to creativity and that she is only limited by her imagination.

The WINE Cellar By Jamie Blair, Shavano Park Resident

The month of September is typically still hot here in Texas and there aren't many ways to cool off. How about a wine tasting? Wine tastings at a winery can be fun, informational, and sometimes refreshing when you find or discover a wine you never thought you might enjoy, especially if it is chilled during the hot months!

In the event you host a party or event, and can share some good times with your friends by hosting a wine tasting, DO IT! You can either host one at your house or go with some friends to a winery! Nothing makes a tasting more enjoyable than sharing it with friends. Here are some tips to think about when hosting a wine tasting party OR attending a tasting with friends:

- 1. Always start with lightest wine and taste to your darkest wine (white to red) and taste sweet to dry. The wines take on much more bitter tastes if there isn't a plan to taste and/or if you bounce around.
- 2. Pace yourself, pace yourself, pace yourself! This is so important. This is about tasting the wine, enjoying the flavors, and nuances. If you mute your senses by overindulging, you will miss the real enjoyment!

- **3.** Don't chug your wine and ask for a refill; it isn't beer! An amateur move, and offensive to the host/hostess conducting the tasting. Wine is meant to be sipped!
- 4. Swirl the wine and sniff before drinking! This releases the aromas that activate your sense of smell. The smell is often based on personal perception and experience. Don't be frustrated if you don't smell the earth or fruits, as the server suggests.
- **5.** Don't be intimidated by words like earthy, grassy, forest, acidic, etc. Your mind and your nose will find what best fits your personal experience.
- 6. Don't wear perfumes or colognes! Much of what we taste is strongly affected by what we first smell. If you have on perfume/cologne, it will diminish not only your ability to fully smell and taste the wine, but it could impact those sitting around you as well.
- 7. Ask for Oyster crackers or a similar plain piece of bread to help "cleanse the palate" between tastings!

At the Stray Grape, we have our tastings organized by basic types of wine. You select from preset flights of our most popular red wines, white wines, a combination of red and white wines, or sweet wines. This allows you to begin by focusing on the type of wines that you generally enjoy. If you are new to wine tasting, tell us and we will begin by asking you questions and perhaps offering a few sips of some wines to determine what could be the best way to begin.

Tasting wines in small sips, side by side, really can help you narrow in on what type or variety suits your palate the best. You can expect that you may not like every wine you taste. Each variety of grape and each region of the world where grapes are grown can produce wines that have the same name, but different tastes. Wine tasting can help you become more knowledgeable about what you like and don't like. It is just as important to know what you don't like as what you do like so you don't make a mistake when ordering.

Usually, after a tasting, we give you a chance to try something new, and if you are fortunate, you may find some wines that you can purchase and take home to share and enjoy from your wine tasting experience. Eldercare and your TAXES

As nursing homes and eldercare facilities have been in lockdown this year, you may have suddenly taken on primary caregiver responsibilities for a loved one. It's a tough job and one that only becomes more daunting as the bills pile up. But there are some critical tax deductions you can take as a caregiver that can free up funds to provide the best care possible.

The *Child Tax Credit (CTC)* was expanded a few years ago to allow taxpayers to claim an up to \$500 credit for an adult-dependent, which can include an elderly parent or a sibling, in-law, or friend. The dependent needs to meet specific requirements, including being a legal U.S. citizen or national. Through 2025, the credit phases out at \$200,000 of modified adjusted gross income or \$400,000 for married couples filing jointly, which is more than twice the pre-2018 income threshold.

The CTC is not to be confused with the *Child and Dependent Care Credit*. If you're a parent, you may recognize this tax credit as the one that includes daycare expenses. It can be used for eldercare expenses as well, as long as the cost was incurred to assure the dependent's well-being and protection. Caring for a spouse or other adult dependent can be a qualifying expense if they are physically or mentally not able to care for themselves. The limit for the Child and Dependent Care Credit is \$3,000 for one qualifying individual or \$6,000 for two or more qualifying individuals.

Medical expenses can also be a valuable deduction source if those expenses surpass your standard deduction limit. Usually, a healthy individual or family wouldn't come close to exceeding that amount but, when adding in the cost of eldercare, expenses can skyrocket. These expenses that can be used to compute your tax deduction include:

- Improvements made to accommodate a home for caregiving, including adding ramps or lifts, widening doorways, modifying bathrooms and kitchens for accessibility, and more.
- Acupuncture and chiropractic care, which are alternative treatments not usually covered by insurance.
- Eye exams, eyeglasses, and eye surgery, as well as hearing aids and dental treatments.
- Medical supplies, including prescription medicine, bandages, and oxygen for a medical condition.

Any wages you may pay someone for home health services, nursing services, and even maintenance and personal care services can apply. These can include giving medication, changing dressings, and bathing and grooming the dependent. According to the *IRS*, the services do not need to be performed by a nurse "as long as the services are of a kind generally performed by a nurse.' However, if the person is also picking up groceries, washing dish

es, and performing other household chores, wages for that time must be excluded from deductible expenses.

Each of these tax credits and deductions should be weighed carefully to determine which opportunity affords you the best tax breaks. If you're a single filer who has taken in a parent or another adult dependent, for instance, you may want to consider filing as Head of Household. The change could bump up your standard deduction from \$12,200 to \$18,350, which may outweigh itemized medical deductions. Being a caregiver is exhausting, tireless work. Be sure to secure the optimal tax breaks for your efforts.
